KNOCK ... KNOCK

Yes... I am one of those weird people who believes that calling bells are a nuisance to my mental peace and haven't had one for my apartment.

So I looked through the peephole and saw my cousin. He was staring at a newspaper meanwhile. Oh no!... I knew why he was here. I called out loudly, "Wrong door". After a minute he knocked again. I gave up and opened the door.

He had one of those "I just found a miracle on Google" look that I am so familiar with. I already took two calls from family and one call from a friend since morning, just to ask me the truth about the miracle drug, "Dostarlimab" that could possibly cure cancer did hit every possible international headline.

He walks in and plonks himself down on his favourite chair and smirks smugly and goes on, "HEY Bindhu Chechi ... looks like you may be out of a job pretty soon". I said, "Nope unlikely!". I poured him a cup of tea. I knew whether I liked it or not, I had to be a part of Q&A session and here it was.

He questioned, "Don't you think it's true? This trial was done in MSKCC, one of the best cancer institutes in the world!." I answered, "I don't dispute that it isn't true, 12 patients with advanced colorectal cancer with a unique genetic mutation MMR gene (mismatch repair gene)had a complete resolution of their cancer, and did not require either Surgery or Radiation which is the standard approach for such patients."

He went on, "Wow..isn't that great? Just imagine that people need not fear for cancer if this drug becomes easily available. To that, I gave him a tolerant elder sister knows the best kind of smile and said, "I am afraid I will have to throw a bucket full of ice on that notion. 'Dosartilimab' is not a drug, it's a monoclonal antibody which is capable of attaching to PDI, a receptor found on the surface of T cells. PDI usually puts a break on the body's immune response.

This antibody prevents it from being activated by the tumour which in turn could protect it from the body's immune attack. So theoretically it's not killing the cancer, it's actually helping your immune system to do the dirty deed. However, only 4% of the population may have the MMR gene required to make this successful."



My cousin did not look so chirpy now. He said "Well, at least it's not chemo and you won't lose your hair and have all those terrible side-effects". And I replied, "I am afraid that I have to put a cap on that thought. Immunotherapy has its own side effects which can be disturbing like extreme tiredness, fatigue or even can kill you with uncontrollable inflammation of the lungs, kidney and other organs. It's also not cheap as it costs 8 to 10 Lakh Rupees per injection. It is not really affordable to majority of our population added to which, it's not covered by insurance and you have to continue this injection monthly."

He goes, "Why haven't I found this information when I googled?" I looked at him straight into the eye and said, "Because you didn't knock on the right door. Google is a comforting tool to cross verify medical information. Don't you think it's better to actually go visit your Doctor who has spent decades of his or her life to treat and understand the ailment in which he specialises in!?"

All of us want our patients to have the best possible chances of cure, but a realistic and practical one. So next time before you fill yourself with medical hopes from Google or chatGPT, you just may want to knock on the right door... Knock knock knock.








The Gabbys has added more than 20+ new members this program year. In this section the newbies share what brought them here and what are they looking for in their journey ahead, with The Gabbys.


FIRST CITY IN ASIA TO GET LIT
